THE STARTING OF THE WHEELS

The World's careful reports from the industrial towns of New England leave little room for doubt that the tendency to a revival of business is comparatively strong this week.

It will be impossible to measure these results accurately until exact statistics for the week are made up, but in a general way the news is encouraging.

In short, there is some recovery of confidence in connection with the Wilson bill. The feeling is growing that final action upon it is not likely to be postponed too far into the spring, and which is not less important—that it is pretty sure to be passed without any very radical change in its terms.

To men laying business plans and giving orders for many months ahead this last point is of great consequence. So long as they could not know or confidently conjecture what the general character of this year's tariff legislation is to be felt a natural hesitation about projecting operations well into the future lest something be put into the law to change business conditions in radical ways.

The change is a hesitating one of course, and its extent is not at all what it would be if the issue were finally settled.
