FUN IN DENVER.

DENVER, March 15.—This has been a day of intense excitement in Denver. Scenes unparalleled in the history of the city have been witnessed. Governor Waite, of "blood-to-the-horses" fame, called out the First regiment and the Cheyenne light artillery to attack the city hall and drive therefrom the reform police commissioners, who defied his power. The commissioners were entrenched behind barricaded doors and surrounded by hundreds of armed policemen and deputy sheriffs ready to do their bidding. Nothing was done and the troops were withdrawn.

Threatening demonstrations have been made against Governor Waite, who remains at his residence under a military guard. He was reported to have been alarmed as to his safety before the arrival of the United States troops.

A Mine Sold.

MEDFORD, Or., March 15.—The Hammerly mine contest has been settled and the receiver discharged. Hammerly pays Drew & Co \$2500 for their interest and takes possession of the mine. Kingley & Bull, who claimed an interest in the mine, are left in the cold, and George R and Riley Hammerly get full possession of one of the best mines in Southern Oregon.

WATTA WATTA, March 15.—Walla Walla church people are waging war on saloons, gamblers and houses of ill-fame. The marshal has closed all houses of ill-fame, and petitions are now being circulated for signatures, praying the officials to close gambling houses and enforce the Sunday closing of saloons.
