Children Cry for Pitcher's Castoria.

AS a result of the troubles in South Carolina, growing out of the conflict between the state authorities and the federal courts over the collection of taxes from railroads in the hands of receivers, the house judiciary committee has agreed on a bill which provides that taxes assessed by state, county or municipal authorities against corporate property shall not be classed as debts, to be passed upon in the first instance by any United States court, but shall be collectable by the proper local authorities, whether in the hands of a receiver or not, and a tax sale under such circumstances shall effect the removal of such property from the jurisdiction of the court and receiver. The ordinary rights of application for an abatement of tax are not interfered with.

LINN COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CONVENTION

The county convention of the democratic party of Linn county, Oregon, will be held at the Court House in Albany, on Wednesday, April 4th, 1894, at 10 o'clock a.m. to nominate candidates for county officers; to elect delegates to the democratic state convention, and to transact such other business as may properly come before the convention. Primary meetings will be held at the usual place of voting in the several voting precincts of said county on Saturday, March 31st, 1894, at two o'clock p.m. By a unanimous vote of the county central committee it was recommended that the viva voce system of voting be adopted by the next convention so far as it may apply to the nomination of candidates. Will be Sign II.

WASHINGTON, March 16.—The silver coinage bill, which passed the senate yesterday, will not go to the president until Monday. The senate not being in session today, the vice president cannot sign it until that body meets again Monday. It was, however, presented to Speaker Crisp today, and received his signature.

Representative Bland called on the president today and urged him to sign the silver coinage bill. The president listened courteously to Mr. Bland's arguments in favor of signing, but did not commit himself.

The Situation at Denver

DENVER, Colo., March 16.—This evening Governor Waite announced that the proposition made to him this afternoon by attorneys for the deposed commissioners to submit to the supreme court the question of their rightful claim to the office of commissioners, would probably be accepted by him, but up to a late hour he had not given his final decision. No disturbance occurred during the day, but the militia is ready to assemble at a moment's notice.

A Murder

TACOMA, March 16.—William Cushman and W.W. Russell, farmers, were shot this morning at Lake Tapps, near this city, by John Arcott and his son. Cushman was killed and Russell badly wounded. Both of the Arcotts surrendered to the sheriff this afternoon. The crime grew out of a fight over a county road at Lake Tapps, which has kept the entire settlement in that section at a war for many months.

The Tammanyites

NEW YORK, March 16.—The exodus of prominent Tammanyites from the city seems to continue. Yesterday Police Commissioner John C. Sheehan and his law partner, ex-Judge Edward Browne, who is counsel to the excise board, joined the procession. At Mr. Sheehan's office it was said that his destination was unknown, and that he would be gone for at least a week. Alderman Martin has also taken a travel.

Disatisfied Miners

SEATTLE, March 16.—The Seattle Co. & Iron Company has made a 10 to 12 per cent cut in the wages of its employees at the Gilman mines, and, as a result, trouble is threatened, though none is expected. The cut affects about 300 men, and the Italians employed in the mines are wild and threatening.

Prohibitionists and Democrats Combine

DETROIT, March 16.—The prohibitionists registered two great victories in the general assembly today. The senate defeated the Carpenter local option bill by a vote of 36 to 12, and the house killed the committee bill for municipal and local option by a vote of 42 to 58. The democrats voted with the prohibitionists, the republicans against both.
