Terms of peace with Spain are:

"The president does not now forward any claim for pecuniary indemnity, but requires relinquishment of all claim of sovereignty over or title to the island of Cuba, as well as evacuation by Spain of the island; cession to the United States and immediate evacuation of Porto Rico and other islands under Spanish sovereignty in the West Indies and like cession of an island in the Ladronez. "The United States will occupy and hold the city, bay and harbor of Manila, pending the conclusion of a treaty of peace, which shall determine the control, disposition and government of the Philippines. If these terms are accepted by Spain in their entirety, commissioners will be named by the United States to meet commissioners on the part of Spain for the purpose of concluding a treaty of peace on the basis above indicated."

Peace Now.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 3.—The President has been unofficially advised that Spain accepts the terms presented by the United States.

LONDON, Aug. 3.—Spain accepts our terms of peace preliminary to be signed Thursday and Friday.

NEW YORK, Aug. 3.—The Journal special says Spain accepts the preliminary conditions of peace. Only peace details are necessary to cause hostilities to cease. The peace delegation will be chosen tomorrow.

MADRID, Aug. 3.—Manila advices report much sickness among the Spaniards.

Will Sail Aug. 9.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 3.—Troop A Utah Volunteer cavalry, now at Presidio, will not be sent to Manila but will guard California national park.

The Sick at Santiago.

SANTIAGO, Aug. 3.—Over six thousand Spanish and American soldiers are on the sick list.

Left Chicamauga.

CHICAMAUGA, Aug. 3.—The Fifth Illinois Infantry left Camp Thomas this morning for Porto Rico via Newport News.

For the White Elephant.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 3.—Gen. Merritt will be allowed fifty thousand additional troops, as requested.

On to San Juan.

ST THOMAS, Aug.—An outpost of the American army has now halted at Coamo, about two-thirds of the way to Alibonito, on the road to San Juan.

Colonel Hulings' advance this morning met a detail sent to reconnoiter the enemy. The latter, it was said, had retreated to Alibonito, where they would make a stand.

Garcia's Fight.

PLAYA DEL ESTE, Cuba, Aug. 2.—News has been received here today from General Calixto Garcia and the Cuban forces under him at Mayari, near the bay of Nipe, on the north coast of the province of Santiago de Cuba.

The report is that General Garcia has been in a heavy fight with Spanish troops. A large body of Cuban reinforcements has reached General Garcia, and the impression is that he defeated the Spanish in this engagement, or at least held his own.

Trouble With Apinake.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 2.—The officials here make no concealment of their apprehension of serious trouble to follow the execution of our programme in regard to the Philippines. The reports of the military and naval commanders of late have contained warnings of expected conflicts with the insurgents, and no surprise will be felt at the receipt of news of an outbreak at almost any moment.

Want More Men.

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 2.—In reply to a dispatch received yesterday from General Merritt, now at Cavite, General Merriam cabled that since the departure of the governor-general of the Philippines five transports with 497 men had sailed from this port.

Scarcely had the message been sent before General Merritt received word from the war department that General Merritt had asked to have his command increased from 20,000 to 50,000 troops.

Need of Courts.

Portland, Me., Aug. 2.—The republicans of the first congressional district held a convention today. After preliminary business the names of Thomas B. Reed was presented, and he was nominated by acclamation. Later Reed appeared in the hall and addressed the convention. After adopting resolutions endorsing Reed and the declaration of principals made by the republican state convention last June, the convention adjourned.

No Extra Session of Congress.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 2.—There will be no extra session of congress though the senate will be called together for ratification of peace, if the present plans of the president prevail.

Weekly Crop Bulletin.

Very warm weather, with a cloudless sky, has prevailed during the week. Harvesting is progressing in all sections of the state. Fall-sown wheat is turning out as good as was expected, and the expectations were high. Harvesting of spring-sown wheat has commenced, and that which has been threshed shows excellent results. In sections of the Willamette Valley, a considerable portion of the oats has been cut for hay. Harvesting of spring-sown grain will not be general for a week or more. The weather has not injured the grain crop, and some correspondents report the crop better than ever before; this applies to quality as well as quantity. Grain harvesting will continue for six weeks longer. In some localities of Eastern Oregon, there are reports of spring-sown grain shriveling to some extent; this condition is not general, and practically applies only to those sections where the raising of wheat is hazardous even under the most favorable circumstances. The hay crop is housed or is being baled. The second crop of alfalfa is being cut. The dry weather is not favorable for the second crop of clover, though so far it has not been injured. The wheat aphid which has been reported from the Willamette valley counties, is disappearing under the influence of the clear, warm weather.

Peach plants are fully ripe, and large shipments to eastern points are being made. Early peaches are ripe and are being shipped. Water melons and blackberries are very plentiful. The apple and pear crops are making good growth and progress. The hop lice have been checked by the warm h. The hops are making good growth; spraying being actively pushed in all good yards.
