## Our Terms Accepted.

**WASHINGTON, Aug. 7.**—Spain's reply made public today. Accepts our terms, and hostilities will close.

**SANTIAGO, Aug. 9.**—200 new cases of fever reported today. There were four deaths this morning.

**LONDON, Aug. 9.**—There are rumors of a battle fought August 4th.

**St. Louis, Aug. 9.**—The Republic special says a second battle was fought at Manila.

**WASHINGTON.**—Alger expects to learn of another heavy battle at Manila.

**A Long Reply**  
**WASHINGTON, Aug. 8.**—The reply of the Spanish government to the peace conditions laid down by the United States was received by the French ambassador, M. Cambon, shortly before 3 o'clock this afternoon. The reply came in sections. Pending official delivery of the answer, speculation was rife as to its contents. There was no further doubt that the length of the reply meant that Spain had not given a simple and direct affirmative answer to the American conditions.

**Shift for Spain**  
**WASHINGTON, Aug. 8.**—Information was received by Adjutant-General Corbin tonight, from Colonel Humphrey, in charge of the transportation arrangements at Santiago, that the Spanish hospital ship Alicante sailed from there today with 800 of the Spanish prisoners for Spain. It is supposed that the Alicante carries a majority of the sick and wounded of General Toral's army, as he would naturally send them first.

**A Big Yield**  
**CHICAGO, Aug. 8.**—The Post today says: "According to reports received by railway companies and business men, the largest wheat crop in the history of the United States will be harvested within a fortnight. The winter wheat yield, which aggregates from 375,000,000 to 400,000,000 bushels, will be increased to the extent of nearly 200,000,000 from the spring-wheat region. The 'bumper' crop of 1891 will be eclipsed this year."

**A Change of Commanders**  
**WASHINGTON, Aug. 8.**—Two important changes in the command of vessels of the navy were announced this afternoon by Secretary Long. Captain Charles D. Sigbee, who commanded the battleship Maine, has been ordered to relieve Captain John W. Phillips of the command of the battleship Texas, now under repairs in New York. It is understood that Captain Phillips will be assigned to shore duty, probably in command of the Mare Island navy-yard, at San Francisco.

**A Big Fire**  
**BIRMINGHAM, N. D., Aug. 8.**—Fire destroyed the best portion of the city of Bismarck this evening, licking up hundreds of thousands of dollars' worth of property. The flames originated in the agent's office of the Nothern Pacific depot. Every drug store in the city is burned and all the groceries but two or three, also two newspaper offices, and the great bulk of the business portion of the city and several blocks of residences. Many people are homeless.

### A Battle at Manila.

On August 6th, at Malate, near Manila, 3,000 Spaniards attacked the Americans, and a fierce battle raged for three hours, resulting in the Spaniards being repulsed with a loss of 300 killed and 300 wounded, while the Americans lost only 9 killed and 44 wounded. The 1st California, Tennessee and Pennsylvania troops were engaged. News from Oregon.

Reasonable equivalents are accepted for most of the required entrance studies. Catalogues will be sent free to all applicants. Persons desiring information may address the president, Secretary J. J. Walton, or Mr. Max A. Plum, all of Eugene, Oregon. The courses offered are those of a good university. There are departments of modern and ancient languages, physics, chemistry, biology, geology, English, elocution, advanced engineering, astronomy, logic, philosophy, psychology, mathematics and physical education. Music and drawing is also taught. The tuition is free. All students pay an incidental fee of ten dollars yearly. Board, lodging, heat and light in the dormitory cost \$2.50 per week.
