On August 6th, at Malate, near Man Accepted. WASAINGTON, Aug 7.—Spains reply made public today. Accepts our terms, and hostilities will close. On August 6th, at Malate, near Man ita, 3,000 Spaniards attacked the Amer-icans, and a fierce battle raged for three bours, resulting in the Spaniards being repulsed with a loss of 200 killed and 200 wounded, while the Americans lost only 9 killed and 44 wounded. 


