New Haven, England, April 1.—Suspected of being a supply ship for the German submarines the Dutch gunboat Lodasquik Van Nassau was captured by two British torpedo boats. The vessel ignored repeated signals to halt. A shot was finally fired across the bows. The British vessel took charge of the vessel. A part of the crew were discovered to be Germans, it is stated, and the captain is unable to produce clearance papers from any port. The cargo of the vessel consisted largely of oils.
