LAYMEN'S MOVEMENT.

The laymen's movement, which is attracting wide attention is one that is bound to reach out into wider fields, touching church work generally While now a missionary movement means eventually a broader scope The laymen are altogether too sluggish in church affairs. Under the pres ent system the minister is about the whole thing, the laymen looking on Instead a church organization should be, for instance, like a football team, organized for team work, with the pastor as the coach, the expert, not to do things himself, but to direct others how to do the proper things. Not just a preacher, a small part of the real work of the church. In the football team each man has his place and plays in keeping with those in the game with him, forming as it were, a machine. A timely illustration is that of the work of the team of Coach Dietz, of Washington State College. The men worked absolutely together, and the result was marvellous. Had even one man been at outs with the others, inefficient in team work, it would have shown in the result, as it did in many other teams. Church organization should be taught team work, and laymen should do the work of the church instead of the pastor. This is the crying need of the day.

The idea is suggested by this laymen's movement, and it is one it is to be hoped is pushed forward, and one which is bound eventually to prove effective, causing a needed transformation in methods, one that shall make the laymen the doers, and not merely the pastor, one that shall build up organizations of laymen and not merely an institution of ministers.
