BIG DAMAGE IN LANE COUNTY

More Than By Any Storm for Many Years, Lane Being Hit Heavily.

Register: Eugene's unprecedented March snow is a thing of the past, but its effects will long be felt. More damage was done by this storm throughout Lane county than by any other in many years. Not only was there loss to property in Eugene, but farmers in some localities lost quite heavily. Many barns are reported to have been smashed in by the heavy snow, and fruit trees suffered.

In the mountains vast areas of timber was damaged by the falling of trees, due to the immense weight upon the limbs. Up to the McKenzie and Willamette rivers, many trees have fallen across the roads, requiring a great deal of work to clear them so that teams may pass.

In Eugene several barns and the old "tabernacle" were caved in by the snow, and as the snow disappears the extent of the damage to ornamental trees and shrubs can be ascertained. It is considerable in some yards.
