The best time to think is after a good night's rest, early in the morning, when alone, braced up by the morning zephyrs, free from the microbes stirred up by the day time traffic.

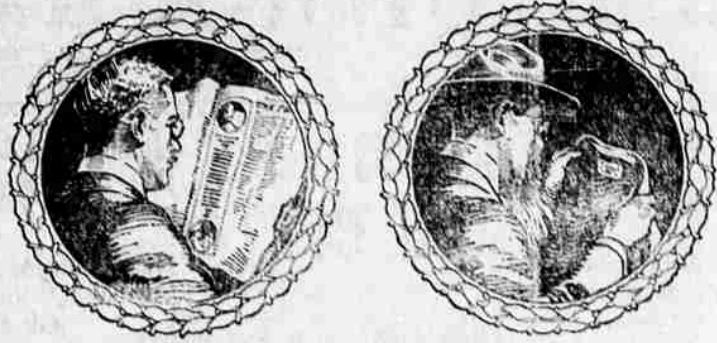

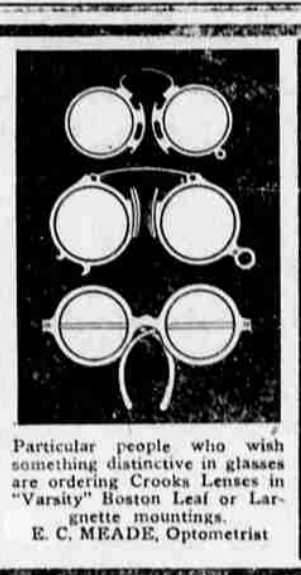
