NEW OWNERS OF GUARD.

Eugene Paper Taken Out of Hands of Receiver and Goes to C. H. Fisher and J. E. Shelton.

Guard: The Eugene Daily Guard today became the property of J. E. Shelton and Charles H. Fisher. The final step in the transaction was completed when Judge Skipworth dismissed E. J. Adams, receiver, appointed January 28, and formally turned the property over to the new owners.

Mr. Shelton will have active charge of the paper as managing editor and Mr. Fisher will be associated with him financially only, his business as editor and publisher of the Salem Capital Journal necessitating his continued residence in that city and requiring his full attention.

The new owners have acquired all the stock in The Guard Publishing company and assumed all its obligations.

The politics of the paper will be Democratic, but it will not be the organ of any party or interest.

MARKET REPORT PORTLAND UNION STOCK YARDS

Cattle—With almost 1200 head of

cattle on the market the light steer class went up about a quarter while the heavier class of stuff went at steady prices. The bulk of sales went between \$8.00 and \$8.75. "She" stuff did not show up very well while heifers and bulls sold at previous quotations. Choice pulp and grain fed steers are selling at \$9.00, hay feds at \$8.50 to \$8.75. Cows at \$7.50 to \$7.80, bulls at \$8.75 to \$6.50, heifers \$7.50 to \$7.75, and calves at \$7.00 to \$7.50.

Hogs—A light run of hogs came forward for Monday's market. Bidding was good and the stuff moved rapidly at steady prices. Tops going at 900. Quality wasn't very noticeable and there was also quite a number of rough unfinished hogs. Outlook fair for a good market.
