SEN. LANE'S GRANDFATHER

It took an entire page of the Sunday Oregonian to enlighten the readers of that publication as to certain remarks made in the United States Senate by Senator Joe Lane. The printed extracts from the congressional record were taken from the files of the 36th congress which convened some fifty-six years ago.

Since when did Senator Lane's grandfather become an issue in Oregon politics? Since when has it become incumbent upon a reputable journal to dig up the ancient and forgotten words of a dead United States Senator for the avowed purpose of discrediting his lineal descendants?

Former United States Senator Joe Lane is dead and buried. Whether he served his state and nation well or ill has no connection with the public record of the junior Senator from Oregon.

When Lane became a candidate for the United States Senate it was his name, and not the name of his dead grandfather that was placed upon the official ballot. When the votes were counted it was Harry, and not his dead grandfather who was elected.

The Oregonian now asserts that Senator Lane was one of the "little group" of willful men who assisted in blocking the vote on the armed neutrality measure. Senator Lane asserts that he was not. The issue is thus joined and the Democrat suggests the wisdom of confining the remarks to the record.
