THE NATIONAL CRISIS

When Congress convened this morning it faced the most serious question ever faced by an American congress since the War of the Rebellion. It is the question of war or peace, with the second alternative already rejected by the American public and the nation unprepared for the first.

That Congress will pass a resolution declaring that a state of war exists between the United States and the Central Powers is almost a foregone conclusion. Our statesmen assert that there can be no other alternative if the nation is to maintain its self respect at home and its standing abroad. Only a complete abandonment of the German submarine campaign can prevent such a resolution from receiving the approval of the majority of the members of congress and such a change of heart upon the part of the Kaiser is not anticipated.

If war comes it will find a united America. The sons of German fathers will be fighting by the side of the sons of Englishmen in defense of the nation which they all love and to which they claim allegiance. The differences of the past will become an ancient forgotten memory. As between Germany and Great Britain the German-American naturally sympathizes with the latterland. As between the United States and any other nation in the world he will be loyal to his adopted country. The German Americans proved their loyalty during the Civil War. They will prove their loyalty in the war which this nation is about to declare against Germany.

There will be exceptions to the general rule. There will be German-Americans who forget their oath of allegiance and who divide their loyalty between the nation of their fathers and the nation which they claim as their home, but they will be few and far between.

When Uncle Sam faces a great national crisis a mere hyphen will not prevent Americans of all nationalities from presenting a united front.
