**KEEP THE STREETS CLEAN**

A campaign of education for cleaner streets is being waged by the civic improvement league. I hope they inaugurate enthusiasm that will not subside after the lapse of a week, but to conduct the campaign in such a manner as will leave a permanent impression on the community.

I have been trying to awaken the social consciousness by appealing to the people for neatness and cleanliness of our streets and vacant lots, and to this end have at various times had the city papers appeal to them with a number of "don'ts on one side and a few extracts of city laws on the other.

The government of the city is making a direct and urgent appeal to you and everyone of its citizens to cooperate with its officials for cleaner streets.

Investigation has shown that a very considerable portion of the dirt and litter found on our streets is caused by carelessness and thoughtlessness on the part of the citizens in their failure to comply with the laws to prevent dirt and rubbish being thrown, swept or scattered upon the streets.

There are some people that will stand in store vestibules or stairways and throw a sack of peanut shells on the walk or street, this is being done every evening and on Sundays, there are people that will stand within two feet of a rubbish can and eat five cents worth of peanuts, they have not got sense enough to open the can when it is by their side and put the shells in it, but deliberately throw them in the street, and other times they do it shortly after the flusher has just finished cleaning the street, I have often seen orange and banana peels thrown in the street when it would have been only a moments time to put them in the street can.

I don't see any way of stopping this depositing of filth and rubbish in the streets only by arresting them and making them pay a fine for it. This I do not wish to do but I am from now on going to enforce the city ordinance.

Official notice to all citizens in reference to clean streets.

Let each one do his or her part and in the future.

Don't fail to provide a covered leak proof metal receptacle for garbage, and to keep it covered at all times.

Don't sweep dirt, rubbish, waste-paper, grass cuttings, or anything else into the streets from your place of business or home, put it in a rubbish receptacle.

Don't pack or unpack, anything on the sidewalk or street without cleaning up your rubbish.

Don't overload or carelessly load any vehicle carrying dirt or any other materials that are likely to be spilled on the streets.

Don't distribute advertising literature in the form of hand bills, circulars, etc., on the streets or yards.

Don't forget that every particle of dirt or rubbish and every scrap of paper carelessly thrown or allowed to find its way onto the highway must later be picked up and removed, and that you, are making your city streets unsightly. F. N. WOOD.
