

RED CROSS. APPEALS FOR NEW MEMBERS

Sixty New Members Are Added
Last Week; Total Member-
ship Now Reaches 171.

Albany Red Cross registers 171 members tonight, adding 60 new members this last week. Membership blanks have been placed this week in Sunrise Addition with Miss Adda Ross, and in North Albany with Mrs. Gregory and the North Albany Sewing Club.

The Red Cross maintains its supervision by means of correspondence with headquarters, with reports and personal inspection, assists in sustaining high standards, and advises with communities on questions of policy and practice.

The headquarters of the Central Committee and that part of the staff stationed in Washington, D. C., are located in a memorial building of white Vermont marble, dedicated to "the heroic women of the Civil War." This building occupies a city block, bounded by Seventeenth and Eighteenth streets, and D and E streets, Northwest, Washington, D. C. Toward the cost of this building Congress appropriated \$400,000 and friends of the Red Cross added another \$400,000, none of the money contributed for relief work or paid in for membership dues, was used in erecting this building.

Our services can be just as valuable in this way, and held in the same high esteem, if our work merits it, as were the works and deeds of the splendid women of the Civil War.

The work is too big to try to explain.
