THE NEW BROTHERHOOD

"There is no longer an ocean," says a French writer, in his joy at the coming of American troops to help France fight for freedom.

The German submarines may have something to say as to whether the Atlantic Ocean has been abolished. But in its deeper meaning at least this utterance is true.

Who would have imagined, three years ago, that within this brief period people so diverse in race, language, environment and material interests as the French, British, Belgians, Italians, Serbians, Russians, Americans, Canadians, Australians and South Africans would be pooling their men and wealth, forgetting their prejudices and enmities and common ideals?

This fact of international cooperation is one of the things that seem almost to compensate for the horror and waste of the war even while we are in the midst of it and the end seems distant and dim.

The "Internationalism" of which Socialists have dreamed is already in the way of accomplishment. International brotherhood is here, demonstrably established, embracing most of the nations that lead civilization.
