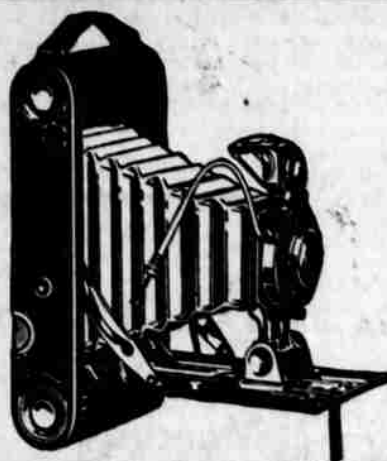

WILLIAM S. HART AS "THE SQUARE DEAL MAN"

William S. Hart, the western character actor featured in "Truthful Lullaby" and "The Gun Fighter," will be seen in a somewhat different role than his famous "bad man" when "The Square Deal Man," a Triangle-Kay-Bee picture produced under the supervision of Thomas H. Ince, is presented at the Globe theatre Sunday.

"The Square Deal Man," which is the work of J. G. Hawks, is a drama of the western plains. It tells the story of a gambler who threw down his cards for a slip of a girl and thereby won his greatest stake. Romantic interest is stimulated by the part the girl plays in turning the notorious Jack O'Diamonds from the game of the roulette wheel to the management of a ranch which he has rightfully won.

Hart, as the square-jawed western gambler displays that virility and quiet forcefulness for which his work is distinctive. While the role is not that of the murderous gunfighter, it is a characterization perfectly suited to the star. He is again the stern visaged person who finds the six-shooter a solution to all difficulties.

Mary McEvoy, a new ingenue of the Ince forces, makes her appearance as leading woman for Hart in this play, which was photographed by Joe August with art direction by Robert Brunton.

Haggard's "She."

Rider Haggard's "She," as presented at the Rolfe last night by Valeska Suratt in the Wm. Fox film, is a most weird and uncanny photograph. The novel was adapted for the movies by Mary Murrillo, who writes many successful scenarios, and she has caused to be worked into the drama many very unusual scenes. Suratt is as good as ever in the part of the hard-hearted but loving "She," whose love for a man transcends through all the ages for 2000 years. The play will be repeated tonight.

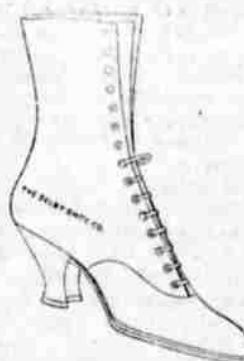
