GERMANS BEWARE!

American Lake, Wash. July 18.—The tallest man in the United States army is Lawrence E. Rushing of the Yakima valley, say his friends. At least, his soldier comrades maintain, if Rushing does not tower over every other soldier, none are higher. Rushing stands 6 feet 7 inches, and Uncle Sam will not accept any taller than that.

Rushing's arrival here caused considerable worry to the quartermaster's office. A cot had to be rebuilt so that Rushing's feet could be cared for. An ordinary army blanket was too small to envelope Rushing's giant frame, and a blanket and a half, sewed together, was issued to him. A special pair of shoes, No. 15-E, were ordered from the East.

But today Rushing is comfortably cared for, and he is rapidly learning the duties of a soldier. "The boys have to look up to me," he said today, "and judging from Rushing's willingness and purpose this remark may be more than a jest."
