"REFORM" IN GERMANY

The accounts of political unrest in Germany are interesting as evidence that the German people are beginning to resent their political impotence.

He is reported to have offered "equal suffrage" to Prussia. It will be a notable step toward self-government if the present system whereby one East Prussian land-holder can out-vote five Berliners is done away with.

And if Prussia and all Germany should be granted this boon, immediately, what would it mean? Merely that the German people were permitted to elect their own Reichstag by fair representation.

The real governing power of Germany is the Bundes rath, which meets in secret. While the Reichstag talks, the Bundes rath acts. It is a council made up of representatives of the various German states composing the empire, and it is chosen not by the people of those states, but by their sovereigns.

And yet it is not supreme. The Kaiser may veto the Bundes rath. The authority is given him by the constitution. There can be no change in the German government amounting to anything until the constitution abolishes that imperial veto.

So there you are! The German nation has been neatly hog-tied by the constitution in which it formerly took such pride. The German Empire is a federation not of the people of its 25 states, but of the royal houses of those states, with the Hohenzollern family at the top.

Suffrage grants, therefore, are spaciou. The dismissal of ministers is unimportant. Foreign Minister Zimmerman may go, Chancellor Hollweg himself may go. But they represent nobody but the Kaiser.

Political reform in Germany must begin at the top.
