teachings of idealism, a refined system of infidelity. Mrs. Eddy was an infidel who spoke piously of Christ and yet denied Him. She was an infidel who adroitly and insidiously labored to foist her system of infidelity upon the world as Christianity it-

self. She has denials of the existence of the soul, sin, responsibility, forgiveness, death and the incarnation of Deity, and final judgment, completely annulling Christ's atonement, human repentance and salvation from sin. But here lies the secret of her success with the worldly minded. They gladly accept any infidelity which comes to them under the guise of Christianity.

Mrs. Eddy did not originate the doctrine that God is the only real existence; that matter is unreal; that man has only a subjective existence as an idea; and that the world is but the subjective idea of the human mind. These dogmas are survivals of ancient philosophy. Her doctrines of the non-existence of matter is but the revival of the old and discarded teaching of idealism which flourished in the days of Plato. She says, "Matter has no life, hence it has no existence." Berkeley, the great representative of modern idealism, declared before her time, "All which really exist is spirit or the thinking principle in God or mankind."

This doctrine led at once to scepticism by taking away the ground for belief in the primary truths which are the very basis of our knowledge and conduct. Hume, the English atheist, followed the idealism of Berkeley to its logical conclusion by denying the reality of matter and the world, and also the mind that perceives material things. Mrs. Eddy runs into the same scepticism, for she says, "Soul or spirit signifies Deity and nothing else. There is no finite soul nor spirit." Here she denies human entity and personal responsibility. Hume denied the existence of cause

and effect, and also declared power to be a fiction and a blunder. So does Mrs. Eddy when she defines physical force as "error," or something unreal. She simply tells us our senses are "error," and thereby declares whatever they report to the understanding is false.

Mrs. Eddy's vaporings on physics and metaphysics are but the rebash of the exploded theories of the atheist Hume; and like him, she also breeds distrust and scepticism concerning the fundamental truths of life and conduct. Her doctrine that matter possesses an occult and malignant property antagonistic to God, is but the revival of a teaching of Plato and ancient heathen dogma discarded long ago. Idealism in all its forms runs inevitably into phenomenal evolutions of God—that God is all and all is God. This is what Mrs. Eddy teaches, and she here destroys all distinction between right and wrong, by destroying belief in human responsibility.

Mrs. Eddy is a Nicolaitan, in her teaching. Nicholas was one of the seven deacons appointed in the ancient church, but he fell and became an apostate. He taught that all evil resides in matter. This is also what Mrs. Eddy teaches. The dogma of Nicholas led to two results: It led to the denial of the physical body of Christ. It led also to the doctrine that matter is evil by nature, and that sins of the body are therefore unavoidable. Sins of the body could be indulged, then, so long as the spirit remained pure. So the Nicolaitans could live in sinless sin. Mrs. Eddy agrees with Nicholas the apostate. She denies the body of Christ incarnate. She also teaches that evil resides in matter; and that man, the spiritual idea, is eternally good. So the Christian Scientist who sins, only lives in sinless sin.

Mrs. Eddy is also a theosophist, in her teaching. The theosophists of India teach that God is all, and all is God. So does Mrs. Eddy. He claims to be in some mysterious way. So does Mrs. Eddy. He says forgiveness is a part of God, hence he cannot sin. Mrs. Eddy, would only be God forgiving himself. But Mrs. Eddy utterly ignores forgiveness; it is because her system of infidelity demands this. Theosophy leads to fatalism. It is responsible for the fatalism which blocks progress and has cursed India for 20 centuries. It has the same tendency among Christian Scientists.

Mrs. Eddy committed an unpardonable blunder in nearly every page of her book, "Science and Health." Unpardonable in a real scientist or philosopher. This blunder is known in logic as "petitio principii." It is popularly known as "begging the question."

Notice this: She denies the existence of soul, spirit, mind and with it all its power of reasoning—and yet, by labored arguments and appeals to her reason she endeavors to prove she has no reason. This is begging the question.

She flatly contradicts the teachings of the Scriptures, in Genesis and the New Testament, concerning the real

existence of matter. If matter does not exist, then there is no such thing as a Bible. Nevertheless she vehemently, and with a show of profundity, appeals to the Bible to prove no Bible exists. And again she begs the question.

Mrs. Eddy positively contradicts the Bible concerning the corporeal senses of mankind. In this also she contradicts the teachings of our schools and universities. History, science, art and philosophy, together with the Scriptures, all unite in recognizing our corporeal senses. However, Mrs. Eddy calls them and their testimony "error." So they are also—

lutely false. But now she constantly appeals to her senses—and here she begs the question again. Begging the question was chronic with Mrs. Eddy. Her ignorant blunder at once places her outside the pale of argument for she at once violates all logic—and Christianity explodes itself.
