Jerome Smith was a passenger to Portland Tuesday.

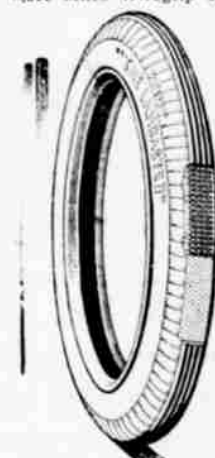
Mrs. Sarah Morris has returned home from an extended visit in Washington.
