**MEATLESS AND WHEATLESS "SACRIFICES"**

In Chicago and several other cities there have been published statements of protest against wheatless and meatless days, on the ground that they inflict burdensome and unnecessary sacrifices. Food Administrator Hoover's reply should give a quick quietus to all such wails, whatever the motive back of them.

It is only lately, he says, that there has been enough meat saved by the observance of meatless days to enable the United States to fulfill even a part of its duty in shipping meat to our needy allies.

As for wheat, he explains, the small surplus of our 1917 harvest over and above our own normal demands has already been sent abroad to help meet the urgent demand. No more can be shipped to our allies at all until next year's crop is reaped, unless the American people are willing to save some of their usual allowance by the substitution of other foodstuffs.

Thus the feeding of many millions of people, with whom we sympathize and who are our loyal comrades in the war, depends on our wheatless and meatless days. It rests with us to determine whether they shall survive in health and good spirits and fighting efficiency or succumb to debility, disease and possibly death from starvation.

And with us it is not a choice between eating and not eating, between food and hunger. Nobody asks the American people to go hungry. It is merely a choice as to whether we shall overeat of certain foodstuffs, according to our old habit, or save part of those foodstuffs by the easy method of substituting for them other foodstuffs no less wholesome and nourishing.

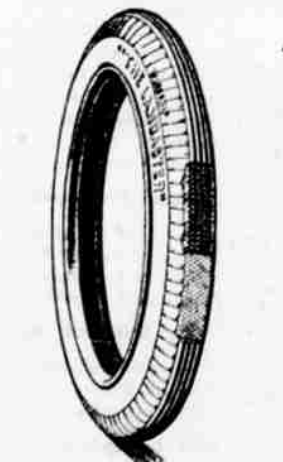
