BIBLE PROPHECY EXPLAINED IN SERMON SUNDAY

In his sermon Sunday on "Signs of Christ's Coming," Rev. Bennett said: "When shall these things be? And what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?"
—Matt. 24:3.
Theologians and commentators have thought Matthew 24, Mark 13, and Luke 17, which record the conversations and predictions of Jesus on this interesting subject, referred to the destruction of Jerusalem. This is one of the greatest mistakes ever made by Bible students. The destruction of Jerusalem was a very small and insignificant event in world history; for Israel lost its importance to the world when Christ was born, completed his mission, and ascended to take the throne of his spiritual kingdom. The special importance and import of Israel to the world was then at an end.

"In this conversation Jesus passed in a brief statement over the course of time from his day to the day of judgment. He dwelled most emphatically upon the matters of greatest importance, such as the culmination of the Gospel in world-wide salvation, and the culmination of wickedness in an opposing world wide apostasy.

"Jesus, in reply to the enquiry of the disciples, uttered three or four distinct warnings against false Christs as the overshadowing menace of Christianity. At the same time he foretold wars and rumors of wars, the rising of kingdom against kingdom, and nation against nation. These, however, were not signs of the end. These were but the "beginning of sorrows," and the "end was not yet." What, then, was the chief and culminating "sorrow"? We shall note that later.

"In a rapid glance Jesus now scans the career of Christianity to the day of judgment. He speaks (1) of universal persecutions and resistance of the Gospel; (2) of national grievances—hatred and betrayals; (3) of great deceptions by false prophets; and (4) of a great apostasy, when the love of many would wax cold because of prevailing iniquities—but that those who endured to the end should be saved.

"Jesus then discloses one of the signs of the end. It is the fact that the Gospel has been preached to every creature—the Gospel universally accepted. The Gospel has never as yet been preached in all the world and to all tribes of mankind. Progress has been made, but it falls far short of completeness. So the "end" is not near at the present time.

"Jesus then speaks of the culmination of all "sorrows" to the church and the world, and of which the false Christs and prophets, the wars, famines, pestilences and persecutions were but the beginning. He speaks now of the consummation of evil in the world. He has already mentioned the consummation of the good in the world thru universal acceptance of the Gospel. The anti-Christ, the man of sin, is the culmination of sorrows to church and world. His appearance follows the triumphs of the Gospel.

"The Lord now speaks of the "abomination of desolation," mentioned by Daniel the prophet: "When ye see the abomination of desolation standing in the holy place—that is, assuming leadership in the church. The 'abomination of desolation' is a symbol of several forms of Satanic despotism which have scourged the church and the world during the ages. Last of all appears Satan incarnate, the anti-Christ, under this symbol.

"Who is this anti-Christ, and when will he appear? It is Satan. After his release from prison at the close of a thousand years, at the close of the millennial period in which the Gospel has triumphed over all the world, then Eatan, the anti-Christ, goes forth to deceive the nations, and gather them together to war; and to compass the camp of the saints about." This great campaign of apostasy is the "great tribulation" of which Christ gave warning to the church.

"The anti-Christ poses before the world as the Christ whose second coming is looked for by the church. The triumph of the Gospel is one of the signs that the time is near at hand. Then begins the great tribulation foretold by Jesus. Jesus said: "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time; no, nor ever shall be. And except those days be shortened, there should no flesh be saved; but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened."

"The 'great tribulation' mentioned by Jesus was not the destruction of Jerusalem or Judaism.
