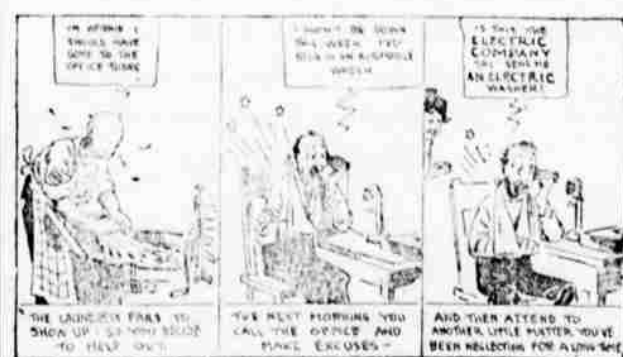

TWO ON FACULTY SENT TO CAMP LEWIS FOR TRAINING

UNIVERSITY OF OREGON, Eugene, Feb. 5.—The University has begun its work of providing specially trained instructors to assist Lieutenant-Colonel John Leader in drilling the men here.

Dean Walker, coach of freshmen football and assistant instructor in gymnasium, and John E. Bovard, professor of zoology, have already reported at Camp Lewis. Professor Bovard will enter the school of arms and study gas and flame attacks while Dean Walker will make a specialty of bombing. At the completion of their training they will return to the University to help Colonel Leader in drilling the students.
