THE AMERICAN FRONT

Every American experiences a thrill of satisfaction in the knowledge that at last American troops are definitely and permanently on the firing line. There is an "American sector" on the battle front in France.

It is not much of a sector yet. It extends, apparently, only a few miles out of the several hundred miles of twisted gridiron lines that run from the North Sea to the Swiss border. But so far as it extends, it is complete. Everything is there that makes modern warfare—trenches, rifles, machineguns, grenades, artillery, shells, airplanes, motor cars, ambulances and all the rest. And that sector will grow steadily and surely, until it becomes a battlefront worthy of the American nation.

We may derive special satisfaction, too, from the location of the sector. It is in conjunction with the French line, flanked by French troops on both sides, and it is close to the German frontier. We owe a debt of gratitude to our French and British associates for placing our fighters, at the very start, so far on the road to Berlin.

Already we are literally almost in Germany. The exact spot is not revealed, but it is known to be on the Lorraine front, in a bend where a gain of only a few miles would actually carry the American army over the German border.

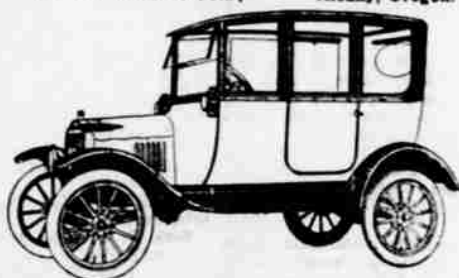

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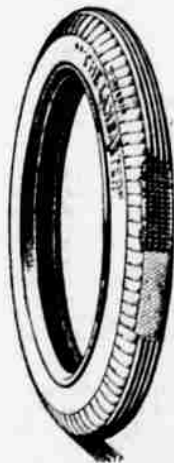
