Von Hindenburg a "Junker."

Capital Punishment.

Capital punishment prevails in all
the states of the Union except Kansas,
Maine, Minnesota, Rhode Island, Wash-
ington and Wisconsin. In Michigan
the only crime punishable by death is
treason. The death penalty was abol-
ished in the state of Washington in
1913, in Iowa in 1872 and restored in
1878, in Colorado in 1897 and restored
in 1901. Hanging is the ordinary mode
of execution, but in Indiana, New York,
Nebraska, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Arkan-
sas, Vermont and Virginia electrocu-
tion is the legal method. In Nevada
hanging or shooting is optional with
the condemned person.

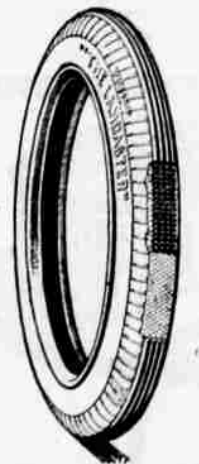

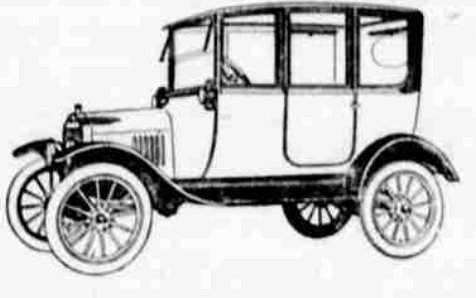
