**CUTTING OUT LUXURIES**

We've been doing moderately well with the elimination of luxuries, judging from the 1917 import figures. Our foreign purchases of such commodities as diamonds, pearls, laces, ribbons, hats, bonnets, feathers, gloves, cosmetics, olive oil, fancy cheese and confectionery have fallen off 20 to 50 per cent compared with the previous year. And the difference is really greater than that, because these percentages are not based on the actual quantity of goods, but on the prices paid for them, which were higher last year than the year before.

There is a notable reduction in liquor imports, a matter for which the general public can take no special credit, seeing that it was accomplished chiefly by a federal order forbidding such importations. More surprising is the fact that we imported only half as much chicle as usual. Can it be that we are actually denying ourselves chewing gum? If so, the women deserve more credit for self-sacrifice than the men, for the latter have certainly not given up their equivalent vice. We imported far more tobacco, cigars, cigarettes and cigarette paper last year than the year before.

We're willing to economize all right, but not on smoking. According to the masculine view, it's necessary to smoke in order to endure economy in other things.
