## Rolled Oats Bread

1 cup liquid.  
One-fourth yeast cake or 1-4 cup  
liquid yeast.  
One teaspoon lukewarm water.  
One teaspoon fat.  
One teaspoon corn syrup.  
One teaspoon salt.  
One 3-4 cup ground oatmeal.  
Two cups white flour.  
Procedure:  
Mix as other yeast bread. Makes  
one loaf.
