SIMPSON FEELS CONFIDENT HE WILL WIN

Declaring that he is satisfied that he will be nominated governor, L. J. Simpson of Marshfield this morning gave out the following interview: "I have covered 15 different towns since Monday and during that time have met and talked with 1920 people besides those to whom I spoke at public meetings. In my judgment there will be a very light vote cast at the primary, owing to the interest in war activities. Unless all signs fail I will receive almost a solid vote in the

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counties of Southern Oregon and will obtain the great majority of the labor vote in the state. The laboring men have been attracted to my candidacy because of my record as an employer of men in Coos county. I am absolutely certain that I will poll a larger vote than any of my opponents in Eastern Oregon and stand an even chance of carrying Multnomah county."
