JUDGE KELLY ENDORSED BY LINN REPUBLICANS

COUNTY COMMITTEE TELLS OF HIS SPLENDID RECORD IN OFFICIAL PAMPHLET

In the official pamphlet which will be mailed to all republican voters in the state the Linn county republican central committee makes the following statement:



Percy R. Kelly, who is a candidate for the republican nomination for justice of the Oregon state supreme court, is 48 years of age and has resided in the state of Oregon for the past 40 years. He graduated in the class of 1887 at Albany college; read law with Judge Charles E. Wolverton, now of the Federal bench; was admitted to the bar in 1892; practiced law at Albany continuously since his admission to the bar until 1910, when he was elected judge of the third judicial district, then comprising Linn, Marion, Polk, Tillamook and Yamhill counties. He yet holds this position, having been reelected thereto in 1916. Judge Kelly has filled the positions of Deputy District Attorney for Linn county, state senator from Linn county and city attorney of Albany, and in each of them he served with credit and honor. He is now serving as a member of the commission of law reform appointed by the supreme court, being the only circuit judge in the state named on this commission. Judge Kelly's work on the circuit bench has demonstrated that he is qualified by natural ability, training and experience to render most successful service as a jurist. Skilled in the law, he gives to his work with his legal training, a broad understanding of men and affairs. No special inter-

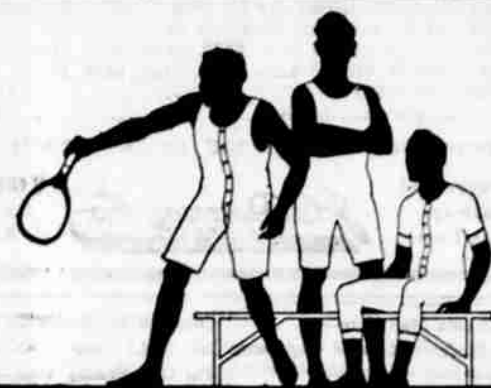

1-2 t. salt.
1 yeast cake.
3-4 c. flour (part substitute flour).
1 t. syrup.
1 t. shortening.

1-4 c. warm water.
