POTATO BREAD

Potato Cookies

2 cups sifted flour
1-2 teaspoon salt
2 teaspoons baking powder
3-4 cup brown sugar
3 tablespoons shortening
1 egg well beaten
1 cup mashed potato
Cream together the butter and sugar. To this add the well-beaten egg and the mashed potato (free from all lumps). Beat until smooth, then add the twice-sifted mixture of flour, salt and baking powder. It will usually not be necessary to add any liquid. Mix until a dough is formed stiff enough to roll. Place on floured board, roll until about 1-8 inch thick, cut in rounds and place on greased baking sheet. Bake 15 minutes in a moderately hot oven or until a delicate brown. Bake more slowly that ordinary wheat-flour cookies.
