My first trip to Tillamook has been a pleasant one. In the midst of one of the most famous cheese sections of the coast my eyes have had an opportunity to feast on evidences of the attendant prosperity; but, strange to say, after being here four days I have neither seen nor tasted any of the cheese. I would like to be shown. There are 20 factories around here, organized into an association with one manager, Carl Haberlach, who does all the selling and general buying of supplies, a most capable man, genial and accommodating, greatly appreciated. There are four non-membership factories. The total sales for a year were \$1,188,845. Last year the producers in the association averaged \$2.44 net per 100 pounds for their milk and the butterfat brought 60c a pound. But they need the high prices, for the expenses are high, land likewise and help very scarce. In fact, men are taking care of 30 and 40 cows without any help except by those in the family.

"Listen to the Mocking Bird" is a continual thing at the Hotel Tillamook, a modern place, for there is a bird here with all of the whistles, trills and shouts in the list.

R. B. Miller, a former Albany college student, is in a garage here. He was at the head of the Eugene Business college for several years. He is married and has two children.

The Methodist and Presbyterian churches have united during the war, with Rev. Chas. E. Gibson, D. D., formerly of the M. E. church of Albany, as pastor. Bruce Evans, who once stirred religious matters in an effective way in Albany, has the devil by the horns and is lambasting him in good shape.

I saw Doug Fairbanks in Happiness, which I viewed in Albany at least two years ago. Albany is one of the earliest cities in the N. W. in film service.

It is also ahead in numerous other things: hotels, bank buildings, pavement, library, stores and there is only one John Catlin in Oregon.
