FREE MOVIE OF AUTO PLANT TO BE SHOWN HERE

There will be transplanted to Albany on July 17 and 18 at the Globe Theater by means of the moving picture film, the second largest automobile factory in the world.

Through the courtesy of the Willys-Overland company of Toledo, Ohio, wonderful motion pictures have been made of their enormous plant by E. Burton Holmes, the world's famous travelogue man and motion picture expert. The pictures show how automobiles are made from start to finish. They show 114 acres of factory floor space devoted to building automobiles—a plant big enough to cover 40 city blocks of average size.

He carried supplies across a shell swept field 400 yards to advanced machinegunners, lived on hardtack for days and is even now, in spite of his broken condition, putting up a hard fight to be allowed to remain at his post.

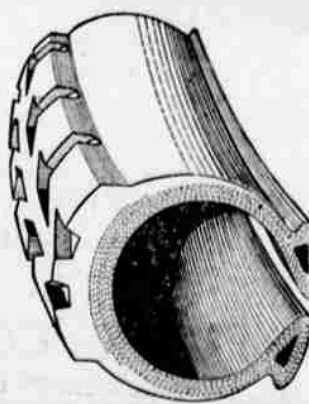
