**BULGARIA**

The attitude of Americans toward Bulgaria is, in general, one of comparative indifference. We do not like Bulgaria. We despise her as the willing tool of Germany, and as a minor power whose war attitude throughout has been dictated by nothing but selfishness and low scheming, without a trace of idealism. But we have a sort of feeling that Bulgaria is not of much importance in the war, militarily or morally—in a word, that she is negligible.

That feeling is due to the fact that we have not come into contact with her. Militarily she is not negligible, because she forms a big arch of the German bridge to Asia and holds in check an allied army at Salonica which otherwise could be used to advantage against Turkey or Austria or Germany. Least of all is Bulgaria negligible morally.

Her crimes against Serbia alone would justify Bulgaria's utter extinction, because she is deliberately engaged in an effort to extinguish Serbia, by methods whose brutality surpasses anything that Prussia herself has practised.

Here are a few of the things that Bulgaria has done to the Serbian people in the southern half of the country given over to her when the brave little land was conquered by the Central Powers. She has killed nearly all the men and taken the rest into Bulgarian slavery. She has enslaved the women, forcing them to work the farms, and seizing nearly all they produced without payment, for the use of her own people.

She has abolished the Serbian church, establishing the Bulgarian church in its stead. She has killed all the Serbian schoolteachers, substituting for them Bulgarian schoolmasters teaching the Bulgar language and Bulgar "culture." She has outlawed the Serbian language, not allowing it to be taught anywhere or spoken in any public place. She has confiscated and destroyed all books written in the Serbian language, including priceless manuscripts of the middle ages preserved in Serbian libraries and monasteries.
