**GERMAN "ORDER"**

Estonia, one of Russia's Baltic provinces, which according to Berlin statements "welcomed" German intervention, seems to be having a nice time of it. Representatives of the Estonian diet announce that German troops, coming in after Estonian troops had already established order, proceeded to establish more order as follows:

They suspended the government which Germany had agreed to recognize, disarmed the native troops, removed the local officials in the towns and country and took all public functions into their own hands, ruling with the aid of advisory committees of German residents, who compose 2 per cent of the population. They introduced German as the official language of the country. Ninety per cent of the people do not understand it, but that defect is being remedied. German has been made the language of the public schools, and the university has been Germanized.

Free speech and all native political activity have been suppressed. Most of the newspapers have been put out of business and the rest are required to print whatever the invaders tell them to. Estonians who protest against anything are thrown into prison.

Germany is charged with "plundering the country, seizing the foodstuffs to such an extent that the native population is left to starve, while German soldiers are permitted daily to send double rations to Germany."
