One Million Sweaters For Army and Navy

The American Red Cross is the
greatest volunteer organization that
the world has ever seen. It was
announced by one of the high officials
in Washington that millions of people
are and have been for some months
working six days a week without a dol-
lar's pay. This includes the members
of the local chapters and all other em-
ployees in this country and abroad.

that the Red Cross has given the
army and navy over 1,000,000 sweaters
for the boys in the service, of which
over 500,000 were made by the mem-
bers of the local chapters. You who

ther the Red Cross' mission of mercy.

women of America."—January Report.)

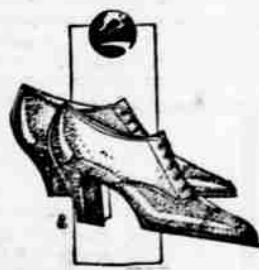
We are the knitting women; weaving swift

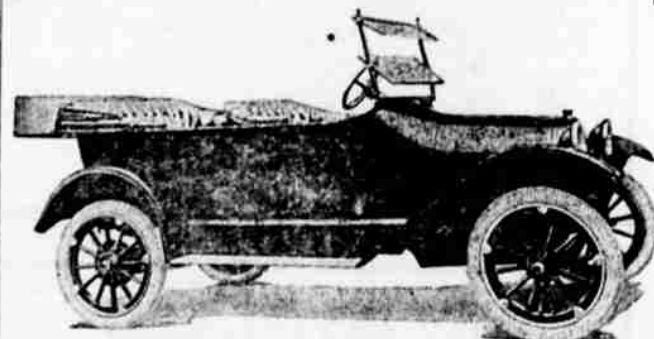
