**THE AUTOCHIR**

Among the new words that have been put into service in the war zone is one invented by Americans. It is "autochir" and, as explained in an American Red Cross bulletin, is the name of a special motor truck train that carries a complete surgical hospital to the front. The last syllable of this word is the first syllable of the old word for surgical, "chirurgical." The "auto" needs no explanation.

This particular motor truck train is interesting as an example of medical efficiency in the war zone. The train is composed of 18 camions. It carries a fully equipped tent hospital of 200 beds in knockdown form but ready for quick setting up and use.

In one truck goes a complete operating room that can be set up, bolted together and put in operation in a few minutes. It is followed by a sterilizing room which can be backed up against the operating room structure. In the other trucks are carried double tenting, strong framework, floors in sections, window frames, heating stoves and a diet kitchen with full equipment.

Special Red Cross construction crews trained for this work go with the outfit. Its mobility and the speed with which it can be put in operation when it reaches its destination make the autochir an important factor in saving the lives of wounded men.

The name may be awkward but we use it with awe and admiration for the sake of the great usefulness of the traveling hospital itself.
