THE FISHERMAN'S FIGHT

The announcement of the government that it intends to protect our fishing boats off the New England coast emphasizes the seriousness of the submarine menace.

The U-boat did its best to drive English fishermen from the sea. That it could not succeed in its campaign of frightfulness with the little ships is just one more detail in England's glorious war record.

The small slowgoing fishing smacks have plied their business not only "as usual" but better than usual, so that in the dark days the people of the British Isles could eke out their scanty meat supply with an abundant ration of fish.

Many tales are told—though few in proportion to the whole record—of these little boats encountering submarines, putting up a plucky fight against them, and frequently worsting the huge wolves of the sea.

The naval officer who reported the engagement concluded his official statement with these words: "This was a fisherman's fight, and without doubt they put up a right stout one. I deem it an honor to have been in command of them."

Such are the British fishermen. We have faith that our own fishermen possess the same spirit. They, too, love the sea and will uphold its traditions of honor.
