THE RHINE AS A BARRIER

Marshal Foch continues to maintain that there will be no safety for France nor for the world unless the Rhine is made a permanent barrier against the Germans.

To Foch, a practical soldier concerned only with problems of military safety, it is a simple matter.

Foch does not definitely ask for the annexation of the German Rhineland, but seems to suggest it.

But such action would be contrary to the principles on which the allies have pledged themselves to make peace.

Whether the Rhine should be made a strategic barrier, as Marshal Foch suggests, is a question for the military experts.

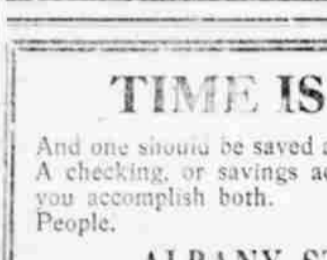
