

PHILADELPHIANS THREW BILLS AT 65TH ARTILLERY

LOREN DAVIS TELLS OF HEARTY
WELCOME RECEIVED IN
QUAKER CITY

Loren N. Davis, well known Albany high school athlete, writes interestingly of the reception of the 65th artillery by the people of Philadelphia upon their arrival there last week. He also remarks that Oregon will have to "go some" to beat it.

"We arrived yesterday in Philadelphia and we sure got some reception," writes Loren N. Davis to his mother, Mrs. J. K. Davis. "A boat with a reception committee came down the river to meet us. I think it had all the bright colored flags the navy uses flying on it.

"For 15 miles before we got to dock every place of vantage was covered with men and women.

Flags flying everywhere "The flag was flying from every conceivable place, making almost a continual line all the way.

"After we docked we were marched off and roll was called. We were then marched up through the 103d Cross reception room. They gave us ice cream, a large piece of cake and a bun with raisins in it, and a cup of coffee, the best I have drunk for some time.

"We were taken from the dock to the street, where we got chocolate, candy, one handkerchief and telegram blanks.

Thousands See Parade "Then it was squads right and we started on a two-mile parade between two masses of people held back by ropes and police. The crowd consisted mostly of women and girls and they threw candy, cigarettes, one or two and five dollar bills.

"When we got to the train each seat had a paper in it which contained the story and picture of the boat on the front page.

"We were also given a box of lunch. It will be hard for old Oregon to do better by us than Philadelphia did."

Lebanon Boy Loses Arm With one sleeve of his uniform hanging limp and empty, Arthur Howell, first returned fighter of company D, 162d Infantry, stood before the members of the Portland auxiliary of this company and delivered personal messages from the boys over there to their mothers and relatives over here. Young Howell left with the old 3d Oregon and lost his arm at the Chateau Thierry fighting July 19. He has been in the city during the past week on furlough and will return tomorrow to Des Moines to a reconstruction hospital for further treatment, after which he will return to Portland to take a position that awaits him. His parents reside in Lebanon. Auxiliary members honored him with a luncheon at the East Side library Tuesday.—Telegram.
