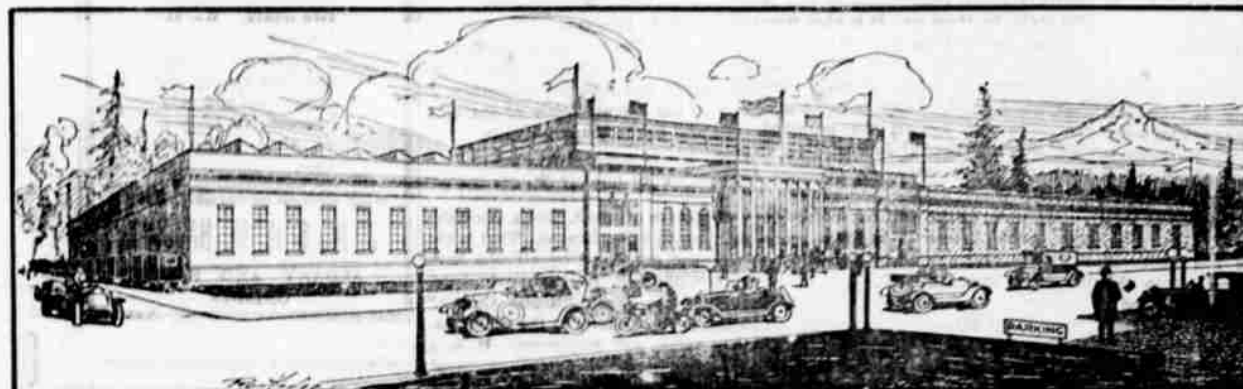




Five Men Pledge Linn County's Quota Your Cooperation Is Needed

DURING THE WAR THE PEOPLE OF LINN COUNTY MET MANY DRIVES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DESTROYING MILITARISM. THEIR EFFORTS WERE NOT IN VAIN. NOW WE ARE CALLED ON TO SUBSCRIBE TO A DRIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING A GREAT LINN COUNTY INDUSTRY—THE LIVESTOCK INDUSTRY. OUR EFFORTS IN THIS DRIVE WILL NOT BE IN VAIN. FOR THE PURPOSE OF ERECTING A GREAT LIVESTOCK PAVILION TO BE USED BY THE STOCKMEN OF THE STATE, IT IS PROPOSED TO RAISE \$250,000.
