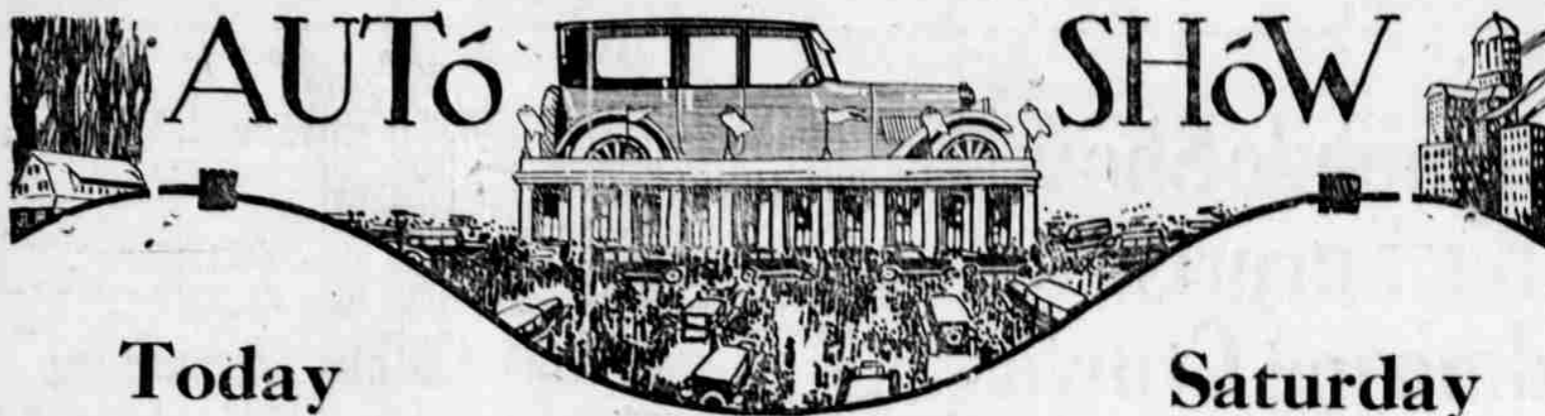

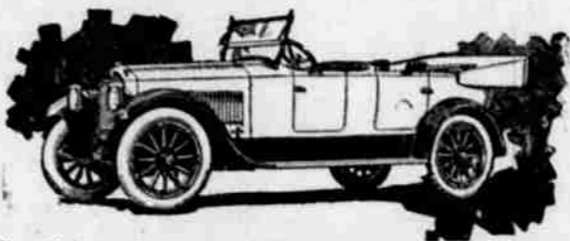

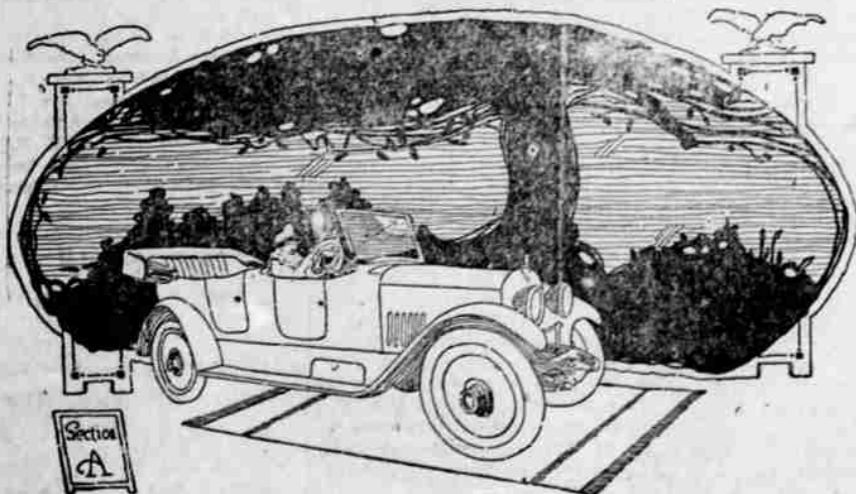
Juvenile Court Case—

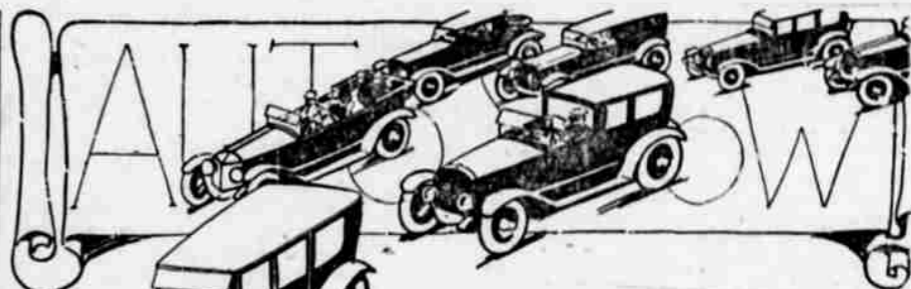

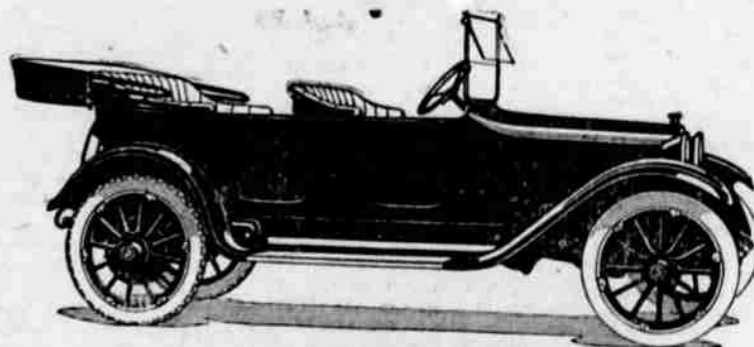

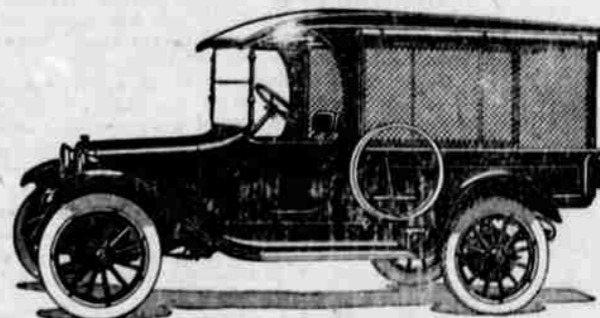
