TWO HUNDRED TREES TO A MILE

New Bedford, Mass., is said to hold the record for New England in the number of trees planted by its citizens in the last few years. That city has planted 4,000 shade trees along 20 miles of streets since 1912. In a bulletin issued by the Massachusetts Forestry Association it is estimated that those trees will be worth over a million dollars to the city in 25 years.

The money value is not all that New Bedford will get from its many plantings. Its streets will be far more beautiful for those trees than they could be without them. Quite contrary to a belief that a city is no place for shade trees, New Bedford citizens realize that the city is where they particularly belong. Trees will thrive anywhere with a reasonable amount of care, and in a thickly settled district they are a source of constant joy and inspiration to the people living or working there.

There are many cities and towns in the country that need to follow New Bedford's example and plant more trees every year. Song birds and children love the trees, and grown-ups will find they are happier for the beauty and shade the trees will offer in a few years' time.

A NATIONAL EXPERIMENT

Why all this fuss about the prohibition amendment?

Prohibition is an attempted solution of the alcohol problem, which has never been solved. People have been

playing with it and theorizing over it for centuries. Here at last is a chance to make a genuine test, on a big and convincing scale.

The thing to do manifestly is to give a fair, calm trial to national prohibition. In a year or two it will be much easier to decide whether total prohibition is a good thing, or whether some modified form of the liquor traffic is preferable—for example, the sale of beer and light wines under adequate restriction—or whether the nation wants to return to the unrestricted sale of all sorts of alcoholic beverages.

A constitutional amendment can be amended if it becomes advisable. In any event, the experiment, while bearing hard on some individuals, will be well worth all the trouble it takes.

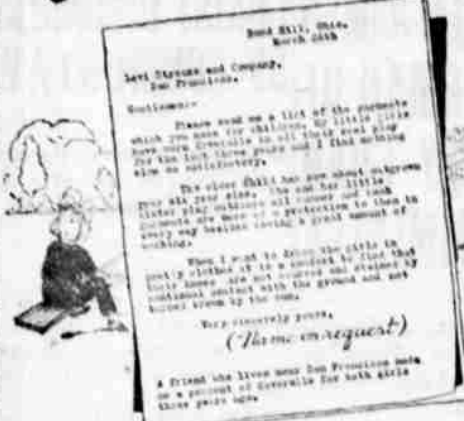

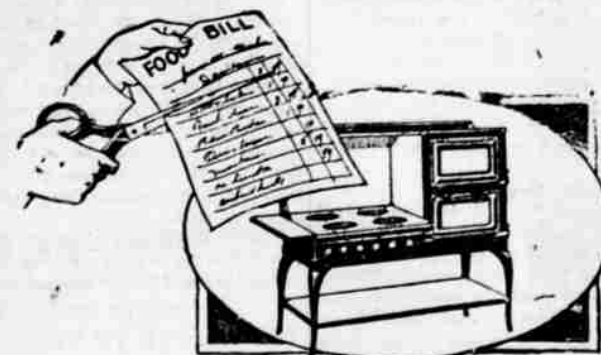
