BELGRADE TO "COME BACK"

Citizens of Serbian Capital Confident Their Beloved City Will Rise From Its Ashes.

Belgrade, the capital of Serbia and Jugoslavia, is now a mere shell of its former self. The Serbs used to be remarkably proud of their metropolis. Did they not possess a city with first-class hotels, electric cars, a boulevard, good shops, and all other modern conveniences, not to mention a profusion of the coffee houses and gardens so dear to the heart of the Serb?

These coffee houses of Belgrade are more of an institution than the tavern ever was in London. A cupful of black coffee in a public garden, a military band playing the weird Slavic songs, and the young people dancing the old folk dances on the grass—these represent the height of contentment to the Serb after a day's work.

During the war, however, there was little coffee drunk in Belgrade, and the Serbs have forgotten how to dance. While the streets of a city are systematically shelled by the enemy, and every able-bodied man is off to war, the citizens think less of comfort and concern themselves with safety.

Belgrade was deserted, but its people, those who survived, are coming back to their wrecked homes. They are still battling with hunger, and their loved city is in chaos, but they are hopeful. As the capital of a Slav republic, Belgrade has, they believe, entered upon a new and more auspicious era of its history.

Mosquito Fleet

Among naval men the mosquito fleet is known as "the second line of defense." It is used in protecting the fortifications and harbors along the coast line, and, like the insect from which it is named, annoys the enemy in every way, at the same time preventing the possibility of a blockade. In the war against Germany the British navy was augmented by several thousands of small and sometimes very speedy vessels, and to this mosquito fleet, manned chiefly by naval reserve men and fishermen, the admiralty paid tribute for its patient and laborious work in laying and sweeping up mines, chasing submarines and patrolling the home waters.

Gathers Unexploded Shells

General Badoglio, underchief of the Italian general staff, has presented the minister for reconstruction of the invaded territories, Signor Fradeletto, his report on the recovery of unexploded projectiles and bombs in the zone of war, and in the localities where the principal battles occurred. From the beginning of the war to October 17, 1918, 7,800,000 did not explode. Up to November 1, 1917, there were collected about 7,000,000 unexploded bombs. From 1917 to the end of hostilities, about 7,700,000 unexploded projectiles were found.

The raking of the ground to find them goes on actively, but it will be a long time before the work generally has been completed.
