TEACHING COURTESY

A course in courtesy and manners has been added to the curriculum of the Brooklyn, N. Y., Girls' high school.

Class discussions dealing with general deportment are held. Essays are written and placards are posted in the halls calling the attention of the pupils to the proper form of politeness.

No one who has much familiarity with young America can doubt the need of such a course. Our boys and girls as a rule are sadly lacking in the finer acts of courtesy. But young America is not to blame—old America is the guilty party.

We live in a hurried, ambitious age. We are all so much in a rush that we forget George Washington's famous maxim, "Life is always long enough for courtesy."

No child who sees ill-mannered behavior on the part of his parents is going to be well-mannered himself, unless he learns it in school. No child who hears bad language or cruel, cutting speech at home is going to be gentle-spoken among his fellows. No child who sees disrespect and thoughtlessness shown to the aged is going to rise to his feet when those older than himself are standing.

It is a good thing for the schools to take up the matter of manners, to interest and encourage the pupils in the daily practice of those courtesies which alone make life endurable, but

if the home falls short, it will be a difficult matter for the school to supply the lack entirely.

As a social and business asset, good manners are better than gold, yet than much finer gold. But their best effect is on the individual himself, who unconsciously becomes finer as he practises the niceties of social usage.

The government is starting a thrift campaign "to teach the American people the value of a dollar." This is glad news. It's the first sign for some time to most of us that a dollar has any value at all.

SELF DETERMINATION FOR GERMANS

The Germans are strong for plebiscites now, when it is a question of losing German territory. But in not one case at issue did Germany ever give the natives any choice in the matter when she grabbed the territory now being restored to its owners.

She went so far once as to promise a plebiscite in the case of Schleswig, which she wrested from Denmark after an unprovoked and shameless war against her little neighbor in 1866. But she never kept her promise.

Now Germany seizes upon the prin-

ciple of self determination as if the robber statesman Bismarck himself had ever discovered it and applied it in his empire building. And she refuses to recognize the patent fact that self determination is precisely what Germany is getting, along with the nations she sought to enslave. The allied treaty provides for a plebiscite in every case where there is any serious question as to the wishes of the inhabitants.
