Textbooks Adopted by State Commission To Be used This Year in Oregon Public School

The following is the list of the books which were adopted by the State Text Book Commission at their meeting at the State House in Salem on June 2. The members of the Text Book Commission are: Mrs. A. E. Ivanhoe, Supt. of Schools of Union County, Oregon; Miss Margaret J. Cosper, primary school supervisor of Salem; Alfred C. Schmitt, banker, Albany; Harrison G. Platt, attorney, Portland; F. M. Tiedjen, superintendent of schools, Marshfield.

The books adopted cover all the subjects that are taught in the schools of Oregon, and no one pupil will use all these books, but only those that are necessary for the particular course of study which he pursues. From actual investigation, State Superintendent Churchill has found that it costs the average pupil \$1.10 per year for the purchase of his books while in the grades.

Some of the books are merely recommended for use on the part of the schoolars, and some are to be purchased by the districts for the use of the school as a whole;
