COLUMBIA RIVER BAR BEST IN U. S.

**Recent Improvements Place
Oregon Port in Lead
As to Harbor**

The recent improvement on the Columbia river bar places Portland and Astoria on the map among the best ports of entry in the United States and Canada. The channel has been deepened to 42 feet and 1200 feet in width which is sufficient to float the largest ship on the seas. The Astoria Budget in commenting on the improvement gives the following description:

The Columbia river right now has the best entrance of any bar harbor in the United States, including both the Atlantic and Pacific coasts, and there are few harbors in the entire world that carry so good entrance depths as does the Columbia.

The reason for this is found in the results attained by the dredge Chinook, during the time she was digging on the course that is in line with where nature had been trying for years to cut a deep waterway. When the Chinook resumed work at the entrance on that course there was just 23 1/2 feet of water at mean low tide and in a narrow channel, the same as there had been since 1860. Surveys now show 42 feet in a channel 1200 feet in width and 40 feet to a width of 1500 feet further. That is sufficient to carry any ship that floats the seas and to insure them safe ingress or egress under almost any weather conditions. It raises the Columbia river from the stream: schooner port that it was a few years ago and places it in a position to accommodate the largest ocean liners or the combined naval fleets of the world.

Compared with other American bar ports, the Columbia river is now in a class by itself so far as a deep entrance is concerned. For instance, while the Columbia has 42 feet at low tide, San Francisco has but 33; New York, 40; Baltimore, Boston Newport News and Norfolk, 35 each, while Galveston and New Orleans have but 30 feet each. Liverpool, the great English seaport, has but 32 feet and of all the British harbors, the only one which possesses a better depth of water at its entrance than does the Columbia, is Falmouth. German has not a single port whose entrance depths compare with the amount of water in the channel leading into the Astoria harbor, while Canada has but two that are in the same class, Halifax and St. Johns.

Steps are now being taken to establish an Astoria harbor improvement project, providing a channel one-half mile wide and carrying 40 feet of water from Tongue Point to the mouth of the river. It also provides for a channel 600 feet wide with a depth of 30 feet, extending to the upper reaches of the industrial center on Young's Bay. That project will be carried out in the immediate future and will make the Astoria harbor by far the best and safest of any in the world.
