Big Demand for U. S. Product in Foreign Countries

LONDON.—There is a very extensive market in Europe for American shoes, particularly on the continent, according to the American Chamber of Commerce in London.

The Chamber has been advised by investigators in that line of business that American manufacturers can make large sales in these countries provided they make up the shoes, according to European styles. Although there is some talk to the contrary, the Continental European public in general does not care for the American and English style of narrow toes and long vamp shoes. On the other hand, the American conservative models are said to be excellent sellers.

The difficulties with regards to exchange and transportation are to be considered, but are not a real obstacle.

The sales policy recommended to American manufacturers is to place an agent in each country or group of countries that could be covered by a single agent. Emphasis is laid on the need for steady supplies and a definite amount of stock should be required to be carried at all times, this stock to be selected by the agent. Payment could be made by letters of credit and the agent should be given two or three months or longer to pay for the goods, thus permitting him to select the most advantageous date of payment with regard to the rate of exchange.

GOVERNMENT SELLS SCRAP WAR METALS

PHILADELPHIA Feb. 11.—More than 1,000,000 pounds of scrap iron, lead, and brass and other metals are to be sold at the Philadelphia Navy Yard by competitive bidding. This material was accumulated from the dismantling of submarines and other vessels used during the war and from big machines used at the navy yard.

SPECIAL SESSION OF LEGISLATURE CALLED TO VOTE UPON SUFFRAGE

Solons of Idaho Expected to Ratify National Amendment

BOISES, Idaho, Feb. 11.—Idaho's legislature called into special session for Wednesday will ratify national suffrage amendment, it is considered certain here.

Before deciding to call a special session, Governor D. W. Davis wrote to every member of the House and Senate, asking their views on the subject. The tenor of these replies indicated that ratification will be unanimous vote.

The session is called for the sole purpose of dealing with the suffrage question, and under Idaho's laws no other matter can be taken up. The legislature will have to meet in one of the local theatres, because the old building which housed the Senate and House chambers have been torn down to make way for the construction of the east and west wings of the new capitol building, at a cost of \$900,000.

The meeting of the special session of the legislature, which under the call will last but one day, will coincide with the opening of the campaign in this state for the Republican party. The Republican state central committee will meet here at the

same time as the Idaho Republican editor's association, and the Lincoln day banquet, always the big Republican gathering of the year, will be held at Boise the day after the special session of the legislature.
