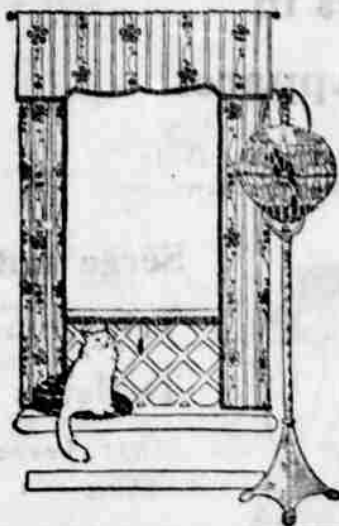

school \$4,774.53 was spent.

The total sum spent from the city fund was \$72,657.48, leaving a balance of \$1,031.72. Disbursements from the bonded road fund were \$50,377.44 and the sum of \$50,844.74 was left on hand at the first of the year.

The total number of warrants outstanding on December 31, 1919 amounted to \$131,252.83 from the general county fund. Road warrants outstanding were \$2,298.62.

Statement of expenditures incurred by the county commissioners in the construction of a gravel plant and improvement of roads amounts to \$110,500.00. Of this sum \$18,000 was spent for three tractors. Purchase of 9 trucks amounted to \$41,400. Two rock crushers cost \$8000. Three donkey engines were bought for \$6000. One gravel plant gravel roll crusher, road graders, gravel drag baskets, road roller and equipment cost approximately \$37,000.

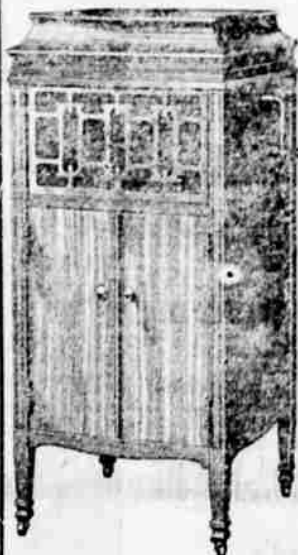
