BED DOES NOT MAKE A HOME

SAN FRANCISCO, March 3.—By Associated Press.—The presence of a bed does not establish a man's home, according to a recent ruling by the United States Commissioner here. Henry Jensen, former saloonkeeper, charged with violating the national prohibition amendment, contended that a bed in his saloon made it his home.

"A homesteader may prove up on his homestead and still live in the city a few months each year; but a former saloonkeeper can't put a bed in a room where there are nearly 200 bottles of assorted liquors and then claim that room as his temporary home," the Commissioner ruled in holding Jensen for the Grand jury.
